# HISTORY OF THE FOUNDATION

In 1985, the Texas Speech-Language-Hearing Foundation (TSHF) was established by TSHA with the first Board of Directors composed of TSHA officers: Richard Stream, Mary Lovey Wood, Joseph Helmick, and Robbin Parish. The creation of a nonprofit foundation appeared necessary because Braniff Women's Auxiliary had endowed a scholarship fund to support speech-language pathology students enrolled in any of four North Texas universities. Between 1985 and 1992, three \$500 scholarships were awarded by the TSH Foundation.

In 1992, Anne Mauzy was appointed by TSHA President Sandy Friel-Patti to re-organize the TSHF. The Board of Directors consisted of Anne Mauzy, President; Tina Bangs, Vice-President; and Larry Higdon, Publicity. Carolyn Wells was soon added to the Board. The Foundation was incorporated as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. Cash-in-hand was \$19,309. When Anne Mauzy left the presidency three years later, the cash-in-hand plus total pledges equaled \$100,000.

## Educational Programs

The Oscar Mauzy Leadership Conference is a collaboration between the Texas Speech-Language-Hearing Foundation (TSHF) and the TSHA Executive Board and serves as a training opportunity for leadership growth and development for both organizations. The conference was named for Oscar Mauzy (1926-2000), a Texas state senator from Dallas (from 1966-1986) and former justice of the Texas Supreme Court (from 1987-1992). He was well-known to speech-language pathologists and audiologists across the state for his dedication to our causes and also for his good fortune in marrying Anne Rogers Mauzy, a speech-language pathologist, who is now listed as the Founding Director of the TSHF. Oscar Mauzy passed away in 2000, and Anne Mauzy passed away in 2018.

The Oscar Mauzy Leadership Conference collaboration with TSHA was not held this year. Future objectives will continue:

- To increase the number of individuals willing to serve in a leadership role in TSHA and/or TSHF
- To increase awareness among cohort members of the TSHA organization and the importance of leaders in TSHA and TSHF
- To provide multiple opportunities for cohort members to acquire and apply information on leadership in TSHA and TSHF
- To provide opportunities for cohort members to serve in a volunteer capacity in TSHA and TSHF

## Ongoing Goals and Strategic Plan Update

### 1. *Fund/Revenue Development*

- Continue to monitor total Foundation funds/investments.
- Generated a net income of \$12,908 through the 2022 awards breakfast event. The auction and Kendra Scott events raised \$5,761.

### 2. *Support TSHF vision and mission through awarding of funds.*

- Awarded a total of \$48,800 at the 2022 Annual Awards Event. (\$37,900 ~ 2021)

### 3. *Nurture relationships with donors of all giving levels.*

- Honored award recipients at convention, on social media and website.
- Utilized Salsa Engage and email blasts to send the TSH Foundation e-newsletters and updates
- Continued to send personal, handwritten notes to donors expressing gratitude for contributions
- Increased social media presence on Facebook and Instagram to promote information about awards and increase number of donors

### 4. *Foster collaborations between TSHF and TSHA.*

- TSHF President and the TSHA President serve as ex officio members of each other's organizational boards.
- TSHF contributed articles to each issue of *Communicologist*.

### 5. *Sponsor educational programs designed to recognize current professional leaders and provide mentors for future leaders.*

- No leadership event was planned for 2022 by TSHA
- Identified Foundation board member to fill Leadership Event Chair

### 6. *Conduct formal reviews of the financial records of the TSH Foundation on a regular schedule.*

- Hired Roberts & McGee, CPA to conduct a financial audit
- Continued to use software platform (Salsa CRM), including a Constituent Record Management (CRM) system for consistently tracking donations/donor contact information and generating monthly donation reports.

### 7. *Continue to implement a Fund Management Policy for spending and investment to provide guidance to the TSH Foundation Board and Finance Committee.*

- A Finance Committee was established in 2018 and is chaired by TSHF Director Emeritus, Sherry Sancibrian.
